Secondary use of these materials requires a permission application.

The copyright of the co-sponsored sessions at the APSR 2021 KYOTO (Luncheon Seminar, Coffee Break Seminar, Sponsored Lecture, Sponsored Symposium, Meet the Professor) belongs to the APSR 2021 KYOTO secretariat and ultimately the APSR. However, a co-sponsor who wishes to make secondary use of the contents of a session it conducted, may do so by submitting an application to the APSR 2021 KYOTO secretariat and obtaining the permission of the Congress President provided that the secondary use is within the scope stipulated under the copyright laws of Japan. Such secondary use must be by the co-sponsor for the benefit of the co-sponsor, e.g. screening at its own event, streaming on its own website, as records and in employee education. The copyright for the contents shall not be transferred to, or the permission for their exclusive use shall not be extended to a third party other than this Congress and co-sponsors. Note that the co-sponsor must also seek direct permission from the applicable session presenter(s) (= copyright holder(s)).

2) Exhibition Space

- The exhibition will be provided online only.
- The exhibition period shall be from the day of the Congress to the final day of ondemand streaming.

- The exhibition plans to offer an online chat system for direct communication with participants as well as a survey function.

4. How to apply
